Eligibility and Selection

Selected students must demonstrate the following:

- Evidence of leadership and service within their high school and community
- Scholastic record and ability
- Demonstrated financial need
- Graduation from an accredited Texas high school
- Acceptance to a participating four-year institution

Financial Information

Selected students will have 100% of their tuition and fees covered for all four years of their experience, provided they continue to meet program requirements.

They will also receive a stipend covering the average cost of room and board at their university.

Other Benefits for Students

The Texas Leadership Scholars program will prepare students for life after graduation, whether their next step is a professional career or graduate school.

Program benefits include the following:

Living Learning Opportunities - Scholars participate in a scholar-specific living-learning community for the first two years of program.

Mentoring - Scholars receive peer, corporate, and alumni mentoring throughout their experience. They also become peer-mentors to younger cohorts.

Undergraduate Research - Scholars receive access to undergraduate on-campus research experiences.
