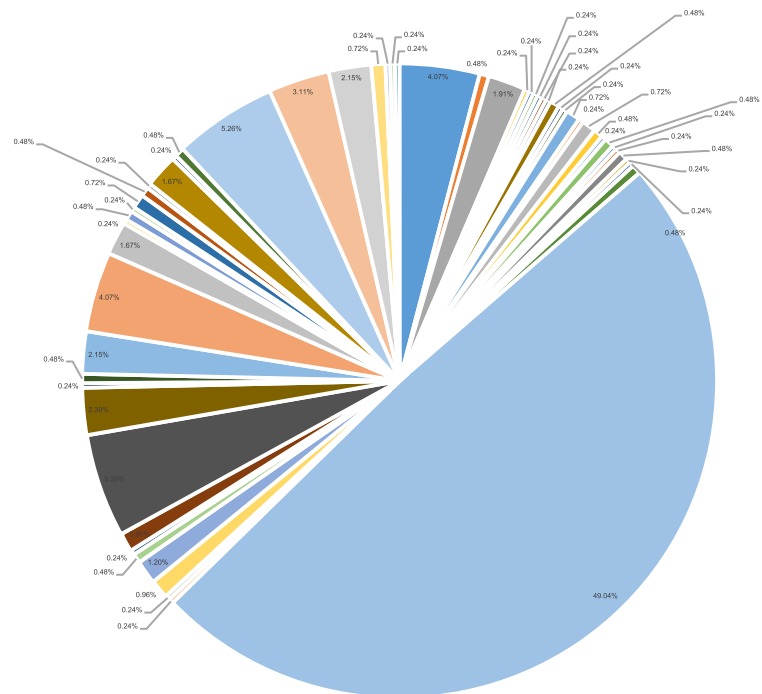

### Del Rio High School Salutatorian Jesus H. Maltos, Jr. '14

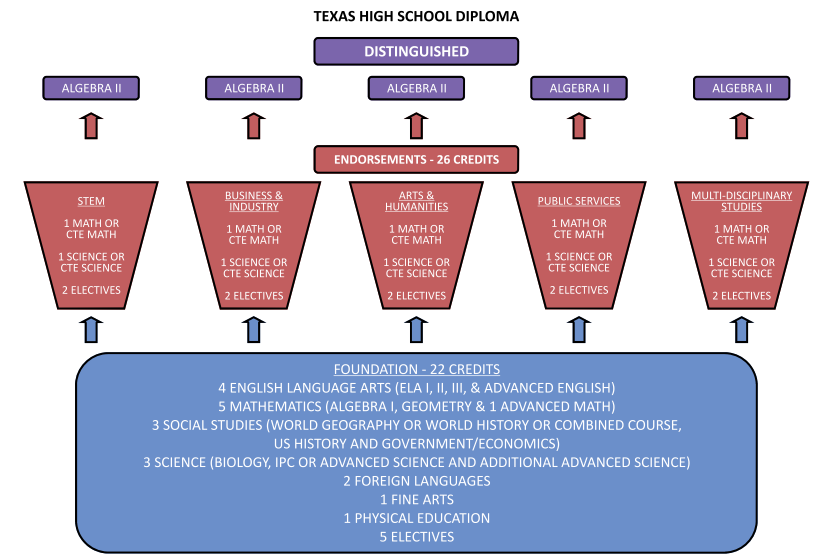
