

NOTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR A PUBLIC
EDUCATION GRANT OR FOR INTRADISTRICT TRANSFER

Dear Parents,

State law enables a student in a school where student performance is lagging—according to criteria applied by the state—to request a transfer to another school in the District or to another school district. The state criteria are that (1) fewer than 50 percent of the school's students passed the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) in two of the last three years or (2) the school failed to achieve an acceptable performance rating from the Texas Education Agency in any of the last three years.

_____ (*name of assigned school*) has been identified by the Texas Education Agency as such a campus. Consequently—if you desire not to have your student remain at this campus—you may:

1. Request a transfer to _____ (*list possible receiving campuses within the District*) OR
2. Request another district to accept your child as a tuition-free transfer student under the Public Education Grant (PEG) program.

Please note that transportation is NOT provided to the new campus or district. If your child currently rides the bus, however, he or she will continue to be able to ride the bus to _____ (*name of present school*). Connecting arrangements will be the parent's responsibility.
