SAN FELIPE LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The San Felipe Lions Club is offering a number of scholarships which are open to any Del Rio High School/ECHS/Premier/Heritage Academy graduating Senior that wishes to pursue a two or four-year college degree. Seniors that wish to pursue advanced educational training in a technical/trade school are also eligible to apply.

Applicants must meet the following requirements in order to be considered by the scholarship committee for awarding a scholarship:

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled or be a mid-term graduate at the schools listed above for the 2022-2023 school year.
2. Applicant must have an overall minimum “C” average for all four years of high school work. A copy of the transcript **MUST** be attached to the **Scholarship Application** as verification.
3. Applicant must submit a **Letter of Acceptance** from a college, university or trade school.
4. Applicant must **write a letter addressed to the San Felipe Lions Scholarship Committee** stating why he/she is eligible for the scholarship. Please indicate all extracurricular activities you are or have been involved in or with. Letter must be in neat, legible handwriting or typed (double-spaced). The completed application and all letters must be submitted in one of the following ways by **Friday April 5th, 2024**:
 - a. via email as a single PDF file to lions.sanfelipe@gmail.com by **11:59PM April 5th, 2024**.
 - b. mailed to P.O. Box listed above. Must be postmarked by **April 1st, 2024**.
 - c. Hand delivered to a San Felipe Lion Scholarship Committee member by **April 5th, 2024**.
5. Any application received after **April 5th, 2024** will be considered late.
6. The applicant must include a valid address, phone number/cell number and recent photograph (pg 2).
7. **Applicants must also include character reference letters from at least two (2) high school teachers.**

Awarding of the scholarships will be based on:

- Completed Application with all requirements
- Character references
- Extracurricular activities
- Financial considerations

The Scholarship Committee will issue the check payable to the recipient. All materials submitted shall be kept confidential and will become the property of this organization.
