SAN FELIPE DEL RIO CONSOLIDATED Independent School District Resolution of the School District Board of Trustees

WHEREAS, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board ("GASB") has adopted Statement 54 ("GASB 54"), a new standard for governmental fund balance reporting and governmental fund type definitions that became effective in governmental fiscal years starting after June 15, 2010, and

WHEREAS, San Felipe Del Rio Consolidated Independent School District ("SFDRCISD") elects to implement GASB 54 requirements, and to apply such requirements to its financial statements beginning with the August 31, 2011 fiscal year; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT San Felipe Del Rio Consolidated Independent School District hereby adopts the following:

Fund balance measures the net financial resources available to finance expenditures of future periods.

The District's Unassigned General Fund Balance will be maintained to provide the District with sufficient working capital to address local and regional emergencies without borrowing. The Unassigned General Fund Balance may only be appropriated by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

Fund Balance of the District may be committed for a specific source by formal action of the SFDRCISD Board of Trustees. Amendments or modifications of the committed fund balance must also be approved by formal action of the SFDRCISD Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that SFDRCISD Board of Trustees commits \$5,622,142 of its General Fund Balance.

AND BE IT RESOLVED that SFDRCISD's financial goal is to have a sufficient balance in the operating fund with sufficient working capital to address local and regional emergencies without borrowing. The District shall strive to maintain a yearly fund balance in the general operating fund in which the Unassigned fund balance is 25 percent (which equals three months) of the total operating expenditures.

The above Resolution is adopted this $\underline{24}^{\text{th}}$ day of June, 2021.
