## **SFDR CISD RELEASES 2020-2021 MODELS FOR LEARNING**

Following recently released guidance from the Texas Education Agency regarding school attendance and operations, SFDR CISD released learning models for students Pre K through 12<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2020-2021 school year. Parents will be called by phone in the coming weeks to select one of three learning options for meeting state attendance requirements. Parents will need to decide whether their children will attend in person at their assigned school; whether their children will be attending online while they are at home, or whether they will choose a hybrid model where their child would attend classes in person and online every other day this coming August.

The Models for Learning and their requirements for daily attendance are unique for Pre-K through 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade, 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade and 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Parents are urged to review each of the options within these models carefully before discussing these with their child's principal.
