## SFDRCID TO HOST IMMUNIZATION CLINIC FOR DEL RIO MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS THIS FRIDAY

SFDRCID has partnered with the Department of State Health Services and Val Verde Regional Medical Center to offer parents of incoming 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students an opportunity to get their required immunizations before the start of school. Whether students are attending school in person or remotely, the state requirement for specific vaccines will still be in effect.

The Department of State Health Services (DSHS) offers back-to-school immunization clinics for students of all ages who don't have insurance. For appointments and eligibility questions, parents are asked to call (830) 768-2800.

SFDRCID and Val Verde Regional Medical Center (VVRMC) will host an immunization clinic at Del Rio Middle School this Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup> for incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students with insurance. There is no wait time, but parents will need to call (830) 778-4513 to reserve their appointment. The clinic is scheduled from 1 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., and has over 100 slots available.
