## USDA EXTENDS WAIVER TO PROVIDE NO COST MEALS TO STUDENTS

Texas Department of Agriculture Commissioner Sid Miller announced that school districts in Texas can opt to extend and operate a Seamless Summer Option (SSO) or Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) this fall through December 31, 2020. This means that SFDR CISD will continue to serve meals to students 18 years and younger, and enrolled students with disabilities up to 21 years old at no cost.

Parents in the community can pick up meals for their children via our grab and go meal pick-up lines located at Garfield Elementary, Lamar Elementary, North Heights Elementary, Calderon Elementary, Dr. Lonnie Green Elementary, and at Roberto "Bobby" Barrera Elementary.
