SFDR CISD SEEKS PARENT INPUT REGARDING GRADUATION CEREMONIES SURVEY TO BE RELEASED TODAY

SFDR CISD is one step closer to finalizing plans for this year's commencement exercises for the 2021 graduating class of Del Rio High School, Early College High School and Blended Academy. Last week, high school seniors were issued a survey asking their feedback on which graduation plan they would prefer to have with current social distancing measures. By an overwhelming majority, the students chose Option 2. This plan calls for two (2) graduation ceremonies separating the graduating class in half and allowing each senior to receive 4 guest passes.

This evening, a new survey will be released to identify which date and times parents would like the two graduation ceremonies to be held. The results of this survey will help in determining which plans are the most favored and allow administration to complete this year's plans for graduation. The survey asks one question, "Which graduation ceremony option would you prefer?". The options are as follows:

- *One graduation ceremony on Friday, June 4, 2021 at 8PM, the second graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 9AM.*
- *One graduation ceremony on Friday, June 4, 2021 at 8PM, the second graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 8PM.*
- *One graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 9AM, the second graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 8PM.*

It is important to note that regardless of the dates selected, candidates for graduation will be selected and distributed randomly so that all students with last names (A-Z) are represented equally at each commencement ceremony. Students ranked in the Top 20 will participate in the first graduation ceremony.

Parents will be issued the survey by e-mail. The deadline for parents to submit this survey will be Friday, April 23, 2021, at 5:00 PM.
