

San Felipe Del Rio CISD provides neighborhood schools within the district to elementary level students. Specific elementary campuses are assigned based on their address. Student in grades 6-12 will attend the following campuses: San Felipe Memorial Middle (6th Grade); Del Rio Middle School (7th-8th); Del Rio Freshman School (9th Grade) and Del Rio High School (10th – 12 Grade).

Enrolling your children for school

- Visit the Student Services Department at 900 Cantu Road. The office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. If you have any questions, please call the Student Services Offices at (830) 778-4170
- Gather the following documents and bring them with you to the registration office:
 - Original certified copy of the child’s Birth Certificate
 - Child’s Social Security Card
 - Up-to-date immunization/vaccination records
 - Guardianship Documents
 - Proof of Residency (any of the following):
 - Electric Bill
 - Cable Bill
 - Telephone Bill (Land Line)
 - Housing Contract or Lease
 - Withdrawal Records from Previous School if available
- The Student Services staff will visit with you on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Your submitted documents will be copied and the originals will be returned to you directly.
- At the time of registration, you will be informed of your child’s assigned campus based on your address.
- Your child’s registration packet will then be sent directly to the assigned campus.
- All students will report to school for the first day of classes on August 17, 2020.

Key Enrollment Facts:

- Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2020
- First grade students must be 6 years old on or before September 1, 2020
