

This past spring, the Education Foundation successfully hosted the 3rd Annual Adventure on the Creek Race which was featured on the television show, Yolo, TX.






Fundraising Efforts – Annual Dinner & Auction




Financial Summary 2022-2023


Public Support and Revenue \$60,000 \$56,892



Programs Funded -ITG Grants




Programs Funded -Scholarships
