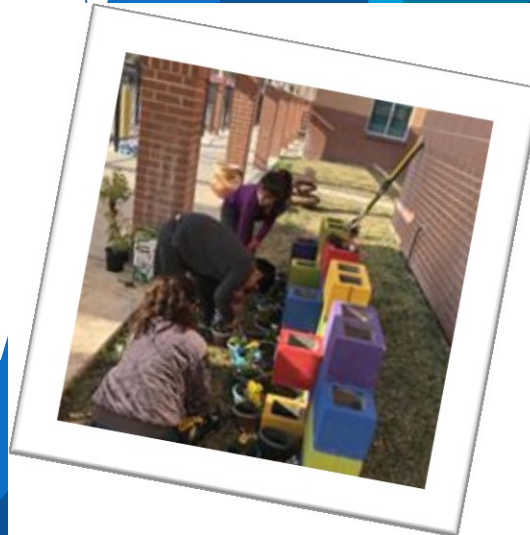
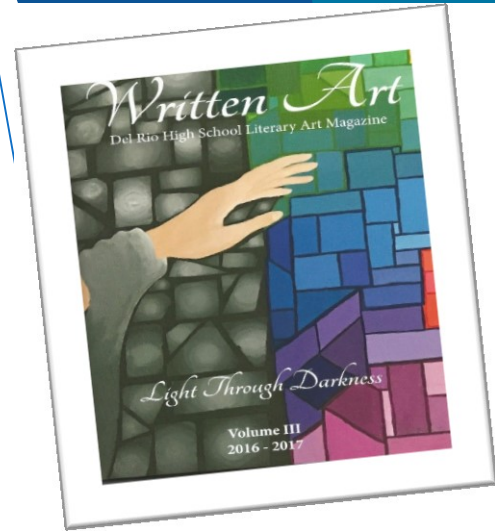

The Education Foundation recognizes that our SFDRCSID teachers, students, administrators, and board stand out for their commitment to academic excellence, creative innovation and positive school spirit.
