## Student Admission Policy 2020-2021



Thank you for your interest in Del Rio Early College High School.

The Del Rio ECHS enrolls students to join a cohort entering they're 9th grade year. The school has a primary goal of affording students from underrepresented backgrounds the opportunity to earn an Associate's degree or 60+ hours and a high school diploma simultaneously. Students are able to earn college credit at no cost to them or their families. As a TEA (Texas Education Agency) designated campus, the Del Rio Early College High School recruitment and enrollment processes shall identify, recruit, and enroll the sub-populations of at-risk students, first-generation college goers, and students of low socioeconomic status. ECHS campuses are required to recruit students of underrepresented backgrounds in an effort to increase opportunities for post-secondary success; however, we encourage students of all backgrounds to apply. The Del Rio Early College High School is made possible through a partnership between San Felipe Del Rio CISD and Southwest Texas Junior College.
