Admission Requirements

- P-TECH is open to all 8th grade students, including various private and charter schools, who will be SFDRCISD students in their 9th grade year.
- A counselor will complete the 4-year plan with the upcoming 9th grader, and an enrollment form will be completed for each student entering the P-TECH Health Science Academy.
- Please note: If a student is selected in the Early College High School lottery, they can still be in Health Science, however, they will not be considered P-TECH. A student cannot be both ECHS and P-TECH, as per TEA guidelines.

Selection Process and Admission into P-TECH

• All students that have interest in the Health Care Therapeutics program of study will be enrolled in the P-TECH Health Science Academy. The students will be placed in a cohort of students and will have Principles of Health Science, BIM 1 and Biology with other Health Science P-TECH students.
