ENROLLMENT

Prior to enrolling in any dual credit course, a student must submit the appropriate written request to the principal no later than 30 days prior to the start date of the course and must obtain any required approvals in order to receive credit for the course.

ELIGIBILITY

A high school student is eligible to enroll in a dual credit course if the student satisfies the criteria described in the TEA *Student Attendance Accounting Handbook*, which can be found at http://tea.texas.gov/Finance_and_Grants/Financial_Compliance/Student_Attendance_Accounting_Handbook/.

A student must demonstrate college readiness in order to qualify for the opportunity to take dual credit courses.
