ENROLLMENT	Prior to enrolling in any dual credit course, a student must submit the appropriate written request to the principal no later than 30 days prior to the start date of the course and must obtain any re- quired approvals in order to receive credit for the course.
ELIGIBILITY	A high school student is eligible to enroll in a dual credit course if the student satisfies the criteria described in the TEA <i>Student At-</i> <i>tendance Accounting Handbook,</i> which can be found at <u>http://tea.texas.gov/Finance_and_Grants/Financial_Compliance/St</u> <u>udent_Attendance_Accounting_Handbook/</u> . A student must demonstrate college readiness in order to qualify for the opportunity to take dual credit courses.
