



E-CIGARETTES

CODE P. 7
HANDBOOK P. 57

Possession of prohibited items: students shall not use or possess tobacco products; cigarettes; e-cigarettes; and/or any component, part, or accessory for an e-cigarette device.

MANDATORY PLACEMENT DAEP

E-cigarette means an electronic cigarette, vaping device or any other device that simulates smoking by using a mechanical heating element, battery, or electronic circuit to deliver nicotine or other substances to the individual inhaling from the device. The term includes any device that is manufactured, distributed, or sold as an e-cigarette, e-cigar, or e-pipe or under another product name or description and a component, part, or accessory for the device, regardless of whether the component, part, or accessory is sold separately from the device.



Marijuana/THC Oil

The student **must** be placed at a DAEP if the student:

Sells, gives, or delivers to another person, or possesses, uses, or is under the influence of marijuana, a controlled substance, or dangerous drug in an amount not constituting a felony.

A student **may be expelled** for engaging in the following conduct while within 300 feet of school property:

Selling, giving, or delivering to another person, or possessing, using, or being under the influence of marijuana, a controlled substance, or dangerous drug, if the conduct is not punishable as a felony.

Consequences from SFDR-CISD Discipline Manual

Drug Felony - **POSSESSION** - Controlled Substance/Dangerous Drug/THC Oil

- Expelled with placement to SGLC for 90 days in attendance.

Drug Felony - **DISTRIBUTION** - Controlled Substance/Dangerous Drug/THC Oil

- Expelled with placement to SGLC for 180 days in attendance

Tobacco

- 30 days in attendance SGLC

Note: Placement determined after due process Level 1 hearing and determination by hearing officer.
