RegulationsEmergen cy Information Form for Employees	Principals will require all employees to complete an emergency in- formation form. The employee will be responsible for updating the information on the form.		
Incident Investigation— Employees	If an employee is injured in an incident at school, a first report of injury will be completed and forwarded to the Superintendent or de- signee who will determine what action has been or should be taken		
Incident / Accident Report for Students	Incidents or accidents that occur on the school grounds or in a school building will be reported immediately to the principal. The teacher will complete a student incident/accident report. The principal will investigate the circumstances surrounding each incident/accident to determine what action has been or should be taken to prevent a similar incident or accident.

Active Threat Exercises	If the District chooses to conduct active threat exercises, which are not mandatory, it must comply with all legal requirements and any additional requirements established by local policy or procedure. Ac- tive threat exercises may include simulated active aggressors or ac- tive shooter simulations.		
Notification	At least two weeks prior to any active threat exercise, a notice will be provided to all individuals required by law.		
Distribution of Notification	Notification of the exercise will be posted through the following mul- tiple distribution networks, including, but not limited to, the District's website and social media platforms:		
	Skylert e-mail system; Class Dojo; <u>www.sfdr-cisd.org</u> ; and facebook.com/sfdr-cisd.org		
Campus Announcement	Each campus will make an audible announcement over the campus public address system immediately prior to the start of the active threat exercise to state that it is only an exercise, not a real emer- gency. If applicable, the announcement will also state if the exercise will include a live simulation that mimics or appears to be an actual threat (such as a shooting incident).		
Data Collection and Submission	The District will collect data regarding the efficacy and impact of the exercise by a district-led survey (Google Sheet). The District will also obtain feedback from students, parents, staff, or other par- ticipants after each active threat exercise by a district-led survey (Google Sheet). All data will be submitted to the TxSSC in accord- ance with methods developed by the TxSSC.
