### **Principles of Audio/Video:**

Career Preparation I

This course is designed to develop basic technical writing and communication skills utilizing Apple iMacs and applications, the Adobe Creative Suite, Final Cut Pro, and Cannon cameras. Students will focus on pre-production, production, and post-production video editing skills with a strong introduction to industry standards. Within this context, students will be expected to develop an understanding of the various and multifaceted career opportunities in this cluster.

## **Graphic Design & Illustration:**

Students will develop skills in illustration for published media and creative interpretation as well as creating graphics used for commercial art. **Certification**: ACA Illustrator CC
