Governance

The District of Innovation concept was passed into law by the 84thLegislative Session in House Bill 1842, which created Texas Education Code chapter 12A.

The law allows traditional independent school districts to access most of the flexibilities available to Texas' open enrollment charter schools.

To access these flexibilities, a school district must adopt an innovation plan as set forth in Texas Education Code chapter 12A and Texas Education Agency (TEA) rules.

District of Innovation for SFDRCISD

HB 1842 provides San Felipe Del Rio CISD with the opportunity to design a comprehensive education plan according to the needs and resources of our district, while maximizing local control.



Eligibility for District of Innovation

To be eligible for designation as a District of Innovation, a school district's most recent academic performance rating must be at least acceptable.

San Felipe Del Rio CISD received a rating of "Met Standard" on the Texas Education Agency 2017 Accountability System.

Benefits

1. Customization.

Districts can develop district of innovation plans which:



 Exercise greater local control over decisions impacting instructional models for students;

 Leads to increased flexibility with regards to state accountability and mandates; and,

✓ Allows school districts to develop innovative approaches to teaching and learning.

Benefits

2. Autonomy.

Districts must submit a District of Innovation plan to the commissioner of education, but approval is not required.

3. Customization.

Districts have the flexibility to implement practices similar to charter schools by seeking allowable exemptions:



Allowable Exemptions may include:



- Uniform School Start Date
- Minimum Minutes Of Instruction
- ➢ 90% Attendance Rule
- Student Discipline Provisions (With Key Exceptions)
- Teacher Certification (Except As Required By Federal Law)

Prohibited Exemptions include (but not limited

to:

- Elected Boards of Trustees
- Powers and Duties of School Boards, Superintendents, and Principals
- PEIMS Public Education Information Management System
- Criminal History Checks and Educator Misconduct Reporting
- Curriculum and Graduation Requirements
- Bilingual Education
- Special Education
- Prekindergarten
