## THIRTEEN OUTSTANDING HISPANIC STUDENTS RECEIVE COVETED NATIONAL HISPANIC RECOGNITION PROGRAM (NHRP) AWARD

The National Hispanic Recognition Program (NHRP) initiated in 1983 by the College Board, has selected thirteen outstanding Hispanic high school students as 2021-2022 National Hispanic Recognition Program Scholars. Five of the students attend Del Rio High School and eight attend Early College High School. These students were selected based on the student's combined verbal, math, and writing skill scores on the PSAT exam taken in the student's junior/sophomore year of high school. Every year, more than a quarter of a million Hispanic students take the PSAT and each year 5,000 high scoring Hispanic students are selected nationwide.
