SFDR CISD SEEKS INPUT FROM STAKEHOLDERS REGARDING ALLOWABLE USES OF ESSER III FUNDS

In March 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act, also known as the ARP Act, was signed into law, dedicating funds for K-12 schools through the Elementary and Secondary School Education Relief (ESSER) III funds. As a result, San Felipe Del Rio CISD is eligible to receive one-time federal funds through the ESSER III program to be spent prior to September 30, 2024, to address expenses and learning loss associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

On Monday, June 7th, the Board of Trustees learned that SFDR CISD would receive additional monies from the federal government which would help recover the loss of funding due to the pandemic.

As part of the District's requirements to receive this funding, SFDR CISD is seeking input on how to utilize the funds to best meet the needs of the District's students and families. We respectfully ask our students, parents, staff, and members of the community to complete this survey and provide us with feedback on the allowable areas of need listed in the survey.
