Parking Guidelines and Rules:

1. A student shall be assigned a parking space designated by a number. Handicap parking spaces are available.
2. The non-refundable parking permit fee is \$20.00 CASH in Exact Change ONLY. Replacement permits are \$20.00.
3. Copy of a valid Driver's License and current Insurance on selected vehicle are required.
4. Parents/Guardians are required to come in and sign students out when a student is leaving campus. Students are required to have an office pass when leaving the parking lot to hand to the officer.
5. A student may not go to their vehicle at any time without administrator approval during school hours.
6. ***A student arrives tardy if they are not in their class by the Tardy bell (8:15 a.m.). Students who fail to arrive from the parking lot and/or are excessively late (arriving after 8:15am). A maximum of 8 unexcused tardies, late arriving in parking lot or late in building from parking lot per school year. Excused tardies must be from Doctors/Clinic appointments (parent written excuses are not permitted for parking).***
7. ***Students with 5 unexcused tardies will have a 10-day parking suspension. Students parking pass will be revoked for the remaining of the school year on the 8th unexcused tardies.***
8. ***Parking Tardies will be documented separately and given a different type of Tardy pass. These specific parking tardy records will be used to document late arrivals. (These are not located on Skyward for parent access.) Tardies involving doctor/medical or inclement weather will be accepted as excused.***
9. Transportation is provided to all CTE students. Students are NOT ALLOWED to drive to CTE Campus.
10. An "Off Campus" student must present a valid school badge to the security guard before exiting.
11. A student is not allowed to bring or take any passengers at any time, unless documented on the application as a direct family member.
12. Traffic laws and school rules will be strictly enforced and may result in towing or immobilization.
13. Students are subject to random drug testing; any student found positive for any drug/controlled substance will have a parking permit revoked and turn in their pass immediately.
14. Students that are subject to placement at DAEP/SGLC due to disciplinary infractions will have their parking revoked for the duration of their assigned placement. Reinstatement of parking will be reviewed and

determined upon student's return to campus.

15. A parking decal must be permanently affixed to the top left side of the windshield.
16. Vehicles parked on school property are under the jurisdiction of the school; therefore, school officials may search a vehicle any time with or without the permission of the student/parent.
17. A student could be called out to their vehicle for any reason.
18. Multiple vehicles must be registered with proof of insurance. The same parking stickers will be used.
19. A student has full responsibility for the security and contents in the vehicle.
20. Be certain that the vehicle is locked at all times and that the keys are not given to others.
21. Parking permit holders are guaranteed their assigned space from 7:15AM to 3:45PM
22. For the safety of all students/staff, students are not to leave off campus. DRHS IS A CLOSED CAMPUS.
23. **All students and parents must attend a mandatory parking meeting prior to purchasing a parking permit** (dates and times will be announced monthly).

❖ **Failure to adhere to the above guidelines will result in disciplinary consequences and loss of parking privileges.**
