- 1/2 cup craft glue
- 1/2 teaspoon borax
- 1 1/2 cups hot water in separate containers
- 1 bottle of fine glitter
- Large mixing bowl
- blue and green food coloring

Directions

1. In your large mixing bowl, combine a 1/2 cup glue with 1/2 cup of hot water and mix well.
2. Add the blue food coloring
3. Mix a 1/2 of a teaspoon of borax into

the last 1 cup of hot water and stir to let the borax dissolve


4. Now pour the borax water into your glue mixture and stir (the added ingredients should start coming together, forming slime).




Strawberry Filled Cupcakes & Cream Cheese Frosting



Cupcake Ingredients:

- Boxed Cake Mix
- Six Large Eggs
- 1/2 cup of melted butter (not margarine)

Strawberry Filling Ingredients:

- One jar of high - end strawberry jelly or preserves
- 2 oz of Cream Cheese
- 1/4 cup of powdered sugar

Mix with food processor or mixer until smooth and thoroughly mixed.

Cream Cheese Frosting Ingredients

- 10 Tbsp butter, slightly firm but not cold
- 10 oz of cream cheese, cold
- 2 1/2 Tbsp sour cream
- 1/2 vanilla extract
- 5 cups of powdered sugar

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 350*. Line muffin or cupcake pan with 24 cupcake liner cups.
2. In a large bowl, add cake mix, eggs, butter and water. Mix on low for one minute until ingredients are combined and then switch to high for approximately one minute until batter is thick and creamy.
3. Spoon batter into cupcake liners.
4. bake for 20 minutes at 350*.
5. Once cupcakes have cooled completely, cut a round plug out of each cupcake with a cupcake corer. If you don't have a cupcake corer, you can use apple corer, but be sure to keep the plug round and evenly cut. Set the plugs aside to use later.
6. Pipe or spoon strawberry filling into each cupcake center. Leave a little bit of room at the top.
7. Take the plugs you removed and close each hole. you may want to pull a little piece of cake off the plug to make it fit better.
8. Frost cupcakes with cream cheese icing.

The Three Brothers

Hades, The king of
The Underworld and
the God of Wealth

Hades is thought to be plotting against the gods, but that is the complete opposite of what he does. In fact he actually helps the gods and does favors for them. For example, Apollo wanted to punish a demigod/giant for assaulting his mother, the Titan Leto, including in afterlife, so Hades (gross out alert!) gave him a regenerating liver. Then Hades cut the liver open and let a vulture feast on it. But even he needed to be happy, so he married Persephone and let his "Helm of Darkness" to rest.

Poseidon was the middle child, always being compared to his siblings. But like Zeus, he wasn't satisfied, so he married Amphitrite and had three immortal children. But he didn't stop there; he holds the record for most demigod children. But he was part of the rebellion, so he was stripped of his immortal powers, and he, with Apollo, were sent by Zeus to single-handedly make the walls of Troy.

Zeus is portrayed as a superman, with zero faults. Some of that is true, and some is not. Though he is the king of the gods, he was actually the youngest of his brothers (Poseidon and Hades) but either way he inherited the sky from his grandfather Ouranos (the primordial deity of the sky). One of his faults was Hera; he could not keep his own vows to not cheat on Hera. Also he, at first, was so bad at ruling a rebellion started. But he also was teaching mortals how to be polite, for example he would go up to your house disguised as a traveler and ask for food, water, and shelter and see how you would react (if you he would slam the door in his face he would be back with his lightning bolts).

Japanese Mythology



Mizuchi

Mizuchi or *Kyuryu*, which translates to "Hornless Dragon" or "Water spirit" can take form of two things. Unlike Raiju, which can take form of over ten animals, Mizuchi can only appear as a snake or white dragon with blue fur running down it's back. This is one of the only known Japanese dragons to have four legs. This creature is commonly assorted with *Ryu*, The first Japanese dragon.



Ryu

Ryu was said to be a multi-colored dragon with fiery-feathered hair covering the area near his head. In many artworks, Ryu is mainly red, and has Blue fur on his back and certain areas around his head, But according to the legend, that appears to be proven false.

The Tale of Tawara Toda

The myth of Ryu, much like many others, is very odd, and can come across strange or random to certain people. I would like to give a quick heads up before you read the following. The first legend involving Ryu, this is about how the jellyfish lost it's bones. According to the legend, Ryu needed to eat a monkey (in some versions, to cure an incurable burn) and sent a jellyfish to go get a monkey for him. The monkey managed to get away from the jellyfish by telling it (as weird as this may seem) his liver in a jar, and had offered to go get it. When the jellyfish had came back and told Ryu what had happened, Ryu had gotten so upset, that he had beat the jellyfish until all of it's bones were crushed.

Raiju

Raiju was said to be a white or blue wolf with lightning for fur and claws that would sear through anything it would touch. When this creature was disturbed or infuriated, it would cause dangerous storms such as hurricanes, tornadoes, or a thunder storm. It's howls would cause gales strong enough to uproot a tree or even a small house. The legend said that when thunder echoes through earth, It would just be Raiju's roars. It usually has the form of a wolf, but in other legends, it can appear to be a Tanuki (raccoon dog) fox, weasel, tiger, cat, bear, porcupine, tapir, elephant, rat, bat, squirrel, boar, rhinoceros, or sea creature. (either shark, dolphin, or whale .) Superstitious people tend to sleep on their stomachs during bad weather to supposedly fend off Raiju's storms. It was said that if someone got struck by Raiju's fierce lightning, they would never get harmed by any type of storm.



Japanese Mythology

A Kirin (pronunciation: Ky-er-in) is much like a unicorn when compared to other mythological studies. As shown in the left photo below, they are shown with antlers, or sometimes even one sharp horn. They are described to have scales on their arms, tail, or legs. The mane is shown to be

made of heavy mist or clouds. Most artworks show the Kirin with a cyan or blue mane much like a lions.

Kirins are extremely powerful. According to Japanese Mythology multiple figures through history have tried to steal its horn. If a person got the horn/antler it was said to grant luck for generations.



Azure dragons are shown to have teal or blue scales running down their body. They have green feather-like scales on their spine, head, and tail. They are known for having long and piercing teeth. According to legends, the Azure dragon is the guardian of the city of Kyoto on the east. It is said to control all forms of water when near it. Even though it has this power, it is known for having earth as its element.

Recipe for Good-Guy Milkshake, Captain Marvel (Adult Supervision NEEDED)

Ingredients for milkshake:

- 1 Raspberry Gillian stick, blue
- 1 Egg
- 4 Egg whites
- 1 bag Patriotic jelly star
- 1 tsp Baking soda

Ingredients for captain marvel logo cookie:

- 1 C of unsalted sweet cream butter softened
- 1 1/2 C Powder sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 egg
- 3 C of flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp cream of tartar

Ingredients for candy sticks:

- 1 package of bamboo sticks
- 1 bag of patriotic jelly stars using the red and blue only
- 1 bag of gummy lifesavers using the red only
- 1 red rock candy stick
- 1 blue raspberry Gillian stick
- 1 chocolate frosted donut

Ingredients for milkshake:

- 5 Scoops of Oreo ice cream
- 1/4 C whole milk
- 2-4 drops of blue food coloring

- Blender or milkshake machine
- 1 8 Oz milkshake glass

- 1 container of chocolate frosting
- 1 bag of M&M's only using the blue and yellow ones
- Whipped cream
- 1 package of gold stars sprinkles

Captain Marvel

Cookie Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- Cover a cookie sheet with parchment paper and set aside
- Using a standing mixer, cream together the butter, powder sugar, vanilla and egg and mix until combined and creamy
- Using a large bowl, combined the flour, baking soda and cream of tartar
- Gradually add in the dry ingredients and mix on low speed
- Using your hands continue to mix until fully combined
- Lightly flour a cutting board and knead the cookie dough a couple of times
- Roll out the dough to about 1/2 inch thick
- Cut out circles and place onto a cookie sheet

- Bake for 8 minutes or until lightly golden brown
- Repeat steps until completely out of dough

Royal Icing Directions:

- Using the standing mixer, combine the egg whites, cream of tarter, vanilla and powder sugar and mix until combined and stiff peaks form
- Split icing into 4 bowls,
- Add in a few drops of red into the first bowl
- Add in a few drops of blue into the second bowl
- Add in a few drops of golden yellow into the third bowl
- Add in a several drops of black into the forth bowl
- Mix until the colors are blended and the shades you want
- Scoop about 1/4 C of each icing colors into a piping bag
- Mix in 2 tsp of water into the Red, Blue, and Yellow icing colors
- Pour icings into the squeeze bottles
- Using the marker, draw out the details of the cookie
- Using the golden yellow icing, outline and fill in the star
- Allow to dry for an hour
- Spray the yellow star with the golden spray
- Using the blue icing, outline and fill in the bottom of the cookie
- Using the red icing, outline and fill in the top of the cookie
- Using the black icing, outline the lines of the star
- Allow to dry for an a few hours before enjoying!

Candy Stick Directions:

- Using the bamboo stick, push the red and the blue stars onto the sticks
- Using another bamboo stick, stack the red life savers

Captain Marvel Shake Directions:

- Combine all ingredients into the blender and blend until

- Using the chocolate frosting and a butter knife, frost the rim of the -- milkshake glass
- Alternate the colors of the M&M's onto the frosting
- Pour in the shake
- Place the donut onto the rim of the glass
- Using the lifesaver stick, push the stick into the back middle of the donut
- Using the star stick, push stick into the left side of the donut
- Using the rock candy, push stick into the right side of the donut
- Pipe whipped cream into the center of the donut
- Using the blue raspberry stick into the left side of the whipped cream
- Place cookie into the front center of the whipped cream
- Sprinkle with gold stars sprinkles
