

Scholarship Application

For Julie M. Skiles Memorial Scholarship – Class of 1984

The family of Julie Marie Skiles is offering a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$500 to a graduating senior student of the Class of 2024, who is presently attending Del Rio High School and plans to attend an accredited university or trade school within one (1) year.

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1) High School Senior who has received notification of acceptance from a university or trade school.
- 2) Applicant must submit a transcript for verification to the high school counselor; who will provide it to the designee for the family.
- 3) Applicant must write a 200-word essay demonstrating reasons for deserving the scholarship.
- 4) Applicant must provide two (2) letters of reference; and Academic or extracurricular activities (dates; positions held and duties)
- 5) A copy of your high school transcript. (Counselor should have.)
- 6) The course of study must be: Business Administration or Management, Art, Music, Interior Design, or Entrepreneurship.

The decision will be made by the family of Julie M. Skiles scholarship committee and will be final. The deadline for receipt of the applications to the Del Rio High School Counselor's Office will be April 19th, 2024.
