EXHIBIT C

HELMET PURCHASE, RECONDITIONING, AND DISPOSAL RECORD

The District may not use a helmet that is 16 years old or older in the District's football program, and a football helmet that is ten years old or older must be reconditioned at least once every two years. The District is responsible for maintaining documentation indicating the age of each football helmet and dates on which each helmet is reconditioned, as well as making this information available to parents. The following log can be used to document the dates of purchase, reconditioning, and disposal of helmets used in the District's football program and can be made available to parents upon request.
